
## **BULLER, Dorothy Jean** (nee Carr)

Once you have completed the sign up process, you will be sent a confirmation email. Click the link in the confirmation email to complete your registration.

#### Have your gift card order mailed to you directly!

- You can order your gift cards online any time and have them shipped to your home address for \$0.73 (includes taxes).
- You pay this \$0.73 when you checkout your order.
- There is a four (4) gift card limit in each order and a \$500 maximum value of the cards.
- Orders are processed four (4) days a week (Monday through Thursday) at 9:15 am ET once payment has been confirmed.

- Online Banking Bill Payment FREE

#### My name is Symphony and this is my story:

I found out I was pregnant when I was 17 years old. I had just moved out on my own and was about to live with my boyfriend. I was angry and then devastated. Everything changed. We didn't tell anyone for four months. Things we once thought

were a priority, like the drama between our friends and trying to make other people happy, no longer mattered. My health, eating right and proper exercise, became a priority. I began to give real thought to my habits and how they would impact the baby, making choices regarding the environments I was willing to be in.

My biggest challenge was stigma, especially from friends and family. People over and over told me I had ruined my life, I even got comments from people on the bus, strangers, who didn't know me, they just assumed I couldn't be a good parent. There was no encouragement, that is until I came to the Rose of Durham's Teen Mom School Program.

Once the doors were opened I attended all the programs available to me. I started with school, then prenatal. I took parenting programs on my own and with my partner. I have eight (8) certificates on my wall from programs I completed. Because each of the programs at the Rose are designed to meet different needs, I was able to obtain a variety of tools to use in parenting and in my relationship. As an individual I was able to figure out my passion, that started me on the road of discovering what I want to be. The supportive counselling helped me to open myself up.

My greatest success to date is my role as a parent, and doing so while attending college and maintaining honor roll status. Based on my accomplishments, my family and friends are finally giving me positive feedback.

My future goal is to become a social worker and work with young moms. I would like to buy my own home, and be financially stable. I also hope to raise my son to become a happy, successful individual.

I don't know if I would of done any of it without the help of Rose of Durham.
